Cognitive Development

1. Foundations for Math

- A. Explores objects with different shapes and sizes
 - 1. Looks at colorful shapes around them such as objects hanging from a mobile or toys on a blanket
 - 2. Looks at different size objects around them
 - 3. Swipes at hanging objects
 - 4. Plays with objects of different shapes and sizes

2. Foundations for Science

- A. Actively explores the environment
 - 1. Uses their sight, hearing, touch, taste and smell to discover and examine objects
 - 2. Experiments with different objects to see how they “work,” such as shaking a rattle to hear the sound or kicking toys on a floor gym to make them move

3. Foundations for Social Studies

- A. Begins to recognize significant family and personal relationships
 - 1. Smiles when a family member picks them up
 - 2. Shows discomfort with strangers
 - 3. Shows pleasure when family members play with them
 - 4. Displays comfort with regular caregivers
