The Clifton School Pre-K FAQ

Can I apply for more than one state funded Pre-K program? Yes, you can apply to any state-funded GA Pre-K program that you are eligible to attend (some programs require that you live in their school district).

Can I apply to both Clifton School GA Pre-K programs: Clifton's and Clairmont's? Yes, when you apply to The Clifton School's state-funded GA Pre-K program, the application allows you to request Clifton Only, Clairmont Only or Either Location.

If I am selected for a GA Pre-K slot at the Clifton School location where my children do not currently attend, am I guaranteed a space for my younger child/children at that location? No, we are not able to guarantee a move for younger children at this time. You can request a transfer for younger children and as spaces open you will be notified.

If I am selected for a GA Pre-K slot, where will my child be during the summer? If there is space still available in our summer camp program, you may register for camp. If the camp is full, your child will remain in one of our classrooms until GA Pre-K starts in August.

Do you have a twin policy for GA Pre-K? If one twin is chosen in the GA Pre-K lottery, both children will be accepted.

What are the GA Pre-K hours, and what if I need care before or after the GA Pre-K hours? The GA Pre K hours this year are 8:15 to 2:45. It is very important that you maintain good attendance for this state funded program. We offer extended care if you need care before 8:15 or after 2:45 for \$500/month. This cost is all-inclusive of morning and afternoon care needs (including afternoon snack.)

If I am not selected for a Georgia Pre-K space is my child able to remain at The Clifton School? Yes, your child may remain enrolled at TCS and participate in one of our private Pre-K classrooms
