Home visits

As a reminder, we launched our pilot home visiting program in November. Some families have already participated in the program. Our teachers and families who have had visits raved about how engaging they were. They reported the children were excited and in awe of seeing their teachers in their homes. Home visits help create a strong bond that positively impacts the teacher's relationships with the child and family. Please know that home visits can also take place at your local public library if you prefer to have a visit outside of your home. We believe that childcare teachers are early relational health professionals. The last few years have been emotionally challenging for all of us. Many of our children spent the first years of their lives interacting with other children and adults, with everyone wearing masks. Home visits are one of the tools we can use to build solid connections and a sense of community after a challenging period. When all of the caregivers in a child's life work together, the effects are positive and last a lifetime.

We are testing this program; therefore, we will start home visits with a limited number of families. Each classroom will have an opportunity to schedule home visits with six families. They will visit three families from November to January and three from February to April. The teachers will choose which families to conduct home visits with based on the children's needs. If you think your child will benefit from a home visit, please let your child's teacher know.

Professional Development

The Clifton School is committed to staying abreast of the current trends and research in early childhood education. Our teachers and staff participate in professional development locally and nationally throughout the year.

- This year, nineteen teachers and staff attended the Georgia Association for the Education of Young Children Conference.
- In October, teachers and staff from both sites attended The Clifton School's annual professional development conference at the Downtown Decatur Conference Center. Our speaker was Brandy M. Locchetta, PhD, BCBA a National Consultant from The Pyramid Model Consortium https://www.pyramidmodel.org/. She facilitated training on supporting children's social-emotional development in the classroom.

- The Executive Director attended the Building Well-Being and Connections for the Childcare Community conference in Chicago hosted by Childcare Aware of America.
- Three mentor teachers and four administrators attended the National Association for the Education of Young Children Conference (NAEYC) in Nashville.
- The Emory Police Department will facilitate active shooter training for both sites in February.
